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# SAINT PETERSBURG COLLEGIATE HIGH SCHOOL EVALUATION: 2014-2015 SCHOOL YEAR

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Saint Petersburg Collegiate High School's (SPCHS) evaluation results have been consistently exemplary each year. SPCHS had met four (4) of its four (4) goals for 2013-2014. 100% of enrolled seniors graduated with a high school diploma, with 96% earning an A.A. degree. 100% of seniors completed two college-level mathematics classes. The FCAT 2.0 Reading passage rate of 97% was the highest in Pinellas County.

For 2014-2015 SPCHS set goals for 90% passage of at least 2 college level mathematics classes, 80% passage of the Florida Standards Assessment in 10<sup>th</sup>-grade English Language Arts, a 90% high school graduation rate, and an 80% Associate in Arts graduation rate.

## GOALS

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1. By the end of the 2014-2015 school year, 90% of SPCHS seniors will have passed at least two college level math courses by graduation. (Baseline: 100%)
2. By the end of the 2014-2015 school year, 80% of SPCHS students who are required to take the FSA English Language Arts assessment will pass. (Baseline: 97% FCAT 2.0 Reading passage)
3. By the end of the 2014-2015 school year, 90% of SPCHS seniors currently enrolled will graduate with a high school diploma. (Baseline: 100%)
4. By the end of the 2014-2015 school year, 80% of SPCHS seniors currently enrolled will graduate with a high school diploma and an Associate in Arts degree. (Baseline: 96%)

## GOAL ANALYSIS

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1. BY THE END OF THE 2014-2015 SCHOOL YEAR, 90% OF SPCHS SENIORS WILL HAVE PASSED AT LEAST TWO COLLEGE LEVEL MATH COURSES BY GRADUATION. (BASELINE: 100%)

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99% of the SPCHS senior class for 2014-15 passed at least two college level mathematics courses by graduation. This goal was met.

### Goal Met

2. BY THE END OF THE 2014-2015 SCHOOL YEAR, 80% OF SPCHS STUDENTS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE THE FSA ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS ASSESSMENT WILL PASS. (BASELINE: 97% FCAT 2.0 READING PASSAGE)

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94% of SPCHS 10<sup>th</sup>-grade students passed the FSA English Language Arts assessment. This goal was met.

### Goal Met

3. BY THE END OF THE 2014-2015 SCHOOL YEAR, 90% OF SPCHS SENIORS CURRENTLY ENROLLED WILL GRADUATE WITH A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA. (BASELINE: 100%)

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100% of SPCHS seniors graduated with their high school diploma during the 2014-2015 school year. This goal was met.

### Goal Met

4. BY THE END OF THE 2014-2015 SCHOOL YEAR, 80% OF SPCHS SENIORS CURRENTLY ENROLLED WILL GRADUATE WITH A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA AND AN ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE. (BASELINE: 96%)

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94% of SPCHS seniors graduated with a high school diploma and an Associate in Arts degree during the 2014-2015 school year. This goal was met.

## CONCLUSIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS

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Evaluation results indicate that SPCHS met four (4) of its four (4) goals for 2014-2015.

100% of enrolled seniors graduated with a high school diploma, with 94% earning an A.A. degree. 99% of seniors completed two college-level mathematics classes. The FSA 10<sup>th</sup>-grade English Language Arts passage rate 94% was the highest in Pinellas County. SPCHS students continue to perform at or near ceiling levels of performance across indices.

Goals for 2014-2015 should be set to demonstrate continued strong performance with respect to the 4-year graduation rate, mathematics course completion, earning of the Associate in Arts degree, and passage of the English Language Arts assessment.
