



High School and Associate in Arts Degree Graduation Requirements for the Class of 2018

High School Requirements:

Complete 14 credits in core content areas:

- 4 English
- 4 Mathematics (one must be Algebra 1 and one must be Geometry)
- 3 Science (one must be Biology and two must have a lab component)
- 3 Social Science (U.S. History, World History, American Government and Economics)

Complete 1 credit in Fine or Performing Arts, Speech and Debate, or specified Practical Arts courses

Complete the following coursework to ensure high school and AA graduation requirements are met:

- Physical education requirement
- Complete two years of the same foreign language to earn your Associate in Arts degree

Students must:

- Earn a passing score on the Florida Standards Assessments in Reading, Writing and the End Of Course (EOC) exam in Algebra I
- Must participate in the Biology 1, Geometry and U.S. History End of Course Exams. If U.S. History is taken as a college course then participation in the U.S. History EOC is not required.
- Maintain at least a high school GPA of 3.0 and a college GPA of at least 2.0 to continue in the program.
- Earn 24 high school credits

College Requirements for an Associate in Arts Degree (A.A.)

In order to graduate from St. Petersburg College with an Associate in Arts degree students are required to:

- Have a minimum Grade Point Average of 2.0
- Earn a minimum of 60 credit hours (Minimum of 36 general education credits plus elective credits which are determined by the prerequisites for your college major)
