
SAINT PETERSBURG COLLEGIATE HIGH SCHOOL EVALUATION: 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR

Saint Petersburg Collegiate High School (SPCHS) had met 4 of 4 goals for the 2015-2016 school year.

100% of enrolled seniors graduated with a high school diploma, with 97% earning an A.A. degree. 100% of seniors completed two college-level mathematics classes. The FSA 10th-grade English Language Arts passage rate of 92% was the highest in Pinellas County. The percentage of school grade points earned was also the highest in Pinellas County.

Goals for 2016-2017 were set to demonstrate continued strong performance with respect to the 4-year graduation rate, mathematics course completion, earning of the Associate in Arts degree, and passage of the English Language Arts assessment.

GOALS

1. By the end of the 2016-2017 school year, 90% of SPCHS seniors will have passed at least two college level math courses by graduation. (Baseline: 100%)
2. By the end of the 2016-2017 school year, 80% of SPCHS students who are required to take the FSA English Language Arts assessment will pass. (Baseline: 92%)
3. By the end of the 2016-2017 school year, 90% of SPCHS seniors currently enrolled will graduate with a high school diploma. (Baseline: 100%)
4. By the end of the 2016-2017 school year, 85% of SPCHS seniors currently enrolled will graduate with a high school diploma and an Associate in Arts degree. (Baseline: 97%)

GOAL ANALYSIS

1. BY THE END OF THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR, 90% OF SPCHS SENIORS WILL HAVE PASSED AT LEAST TWO COLLEGE LEVEL MATH COURSES BY GRADUATION.
(BASELINE: 100%)
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100% of the SPCHS senior class for 2016-2017 passed at least two college level math courses by graduation. This goal was met.

2. BY THE END OF THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR, 80% OF SPCHS STUDENTS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE THE FSA ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS ASSESSMENT WILL PASS.
(BASELINE: 92%)
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85% of 10th-grade students passed the ELA portion of the FSA. This goal was met.

3. BY THE END OF THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR, 90% OF SPCHS SENIORS CURRENTLY ENROLLED WILL GRADUATE WITH A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA. (BASELINE: 100%)
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100% of SPCHS seniors graduated with a high school diploma. This goal was met.

4. BY THE END OF THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR, 85% OF SPCHS SENIORS CURRENTLY ENROLLED WILL GRADUATE WITH A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA AND AN ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE. (BASELINE: 97%)
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98% of seniors graduated with a high school diploma and associate in arts degree. This goal was met.

CONCLUSIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS

SPCHS met 4 of 4 goals for the 2016-2017 school year. 100% of seniors graduated with a high school diploma, with 98% earning an A.A. degree. 100% of seniors completed two college-level mathematics classes. The FSA 10th-grade English Language Arts passage rate of 85% was the highest among high schools in Pinellas County.

SPCHS received a school grade of 'A' for its 13th consecutive year. ELA proficiency (85%) and Mathematics proficiency (85%) as well as learning gains in ELA (80%) and Mathematics (72%) were all at the highest levels among high schools in Pinellas County. The SPCHS 100% graduation rate as well as 100% college and career readiness grades were at ceiling levels.

For the 2017-2018 school year SPCHS should continue to set goals reflecting high standards for course passage, assessment passage and graduation rates.
