
SAINT PETERSBURG COLLEGIATE HIGH SCHOOL EVALUATION: 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR

SPCHS had met each of its 5 goals for the 2018-2019 school year. 100% of seniors graduated with a high school diploma. 95% of these received an A.A. degree. 100% of sophomores were college ready with 95% passing the FSA ELA assessment. 95% of college courses taken were passed with a grade of 'C' or higher.

These goals central to the mission of SPCHS were again set for the 2019-2020 school year. 4 of 5 goals were able to be evaluated. A five-year review of goal data is presented for each charter school this year. This review is included for SPCHS.

GOALS

1. By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, 90% of SPCHS sophomores will be college ready as measured by the College Placement Test or PERT. (Baseline: 100%)
- 2: By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, 80% of the SPCHS sophomore students who are required to take the Florida Standards Assessment in English Language Arts will pass. (Baseline: 95%)
- 3: By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, 90% of SPCHS seniors currently enrolled will graduate with a high school diploma. (Baseline: 100%)
- 4: By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, 90% of SPCHS seniors currently enrolled will graduate with an Associate in Arts degree. (Baseline: 95%)
- 5: By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, 90% of SPCHS students will earn a grade of C or higher in their college courses. (Baseline: 95%)

GOAL ANALYSIS

1. BY THE END OF THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR, 90% OF SPCHS SOPHOMORES WILL BE COLLEGE READY AS MEASURED BY THE COLLEGE PLACEMENT TEST OR PERT.
(BASELINE: 100%)

100% (67 of 67 students) were college ready as measured by passage of the college placement test or PERT. This goal was met.

Goal Met

2: BY THE END OF THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR, 80% OF THE SPCHS SOPHOMORE STUDENTS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE THE FLORIDA STANDARDS ASSESSMENT IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS WILL PASS. (BASELINE: 95%)

The FSA ELA assessment was suspended by the FLDOE.

3: BY THE END OF THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR, 90% OF SPCHS SENIORS CURRENTLY ENROLLED WILL GRADUATE WITH A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA. (BASELINE: 100%)

100% (85 of 85) of seniors graduated with a high school diploma. This goal was met.

Goal Met

4: BY THE END OF THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR, 90% OF SPCHS SENIORS CURRENTLY ENROLLED WILL GRADUATE WITH AN ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE. (BASELINE: 95%)

95% (81 of 85) of seniors graduated with an A.A. degree. This goal was met.

Goal Met

5: BY THE END OF THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR, 90% OF SPCHS STUDENTS WILL EARN A GRADE OF C OR HIGHER IN THEIR COLLEGE COURSES. (BASELINE: 95%)

A 'C' or higher was earned for 94% (2044 of 2181) of classes taken. This goal was met.

Each year, SPCHS receives a school grade of A because students are pre-selected to enter the school based upon student performance. Consequently, goals are set for performance within the school central to its' core mission of graduating students with both a high school diploma and an associate in arts degree in a 4-year timeframe. Each year, SPCHS meets these goals near ceiling levels. SPCHS does set and meet goals for the 10th-grade class to take and pass the ELA assessment. This goal is met each year. Goals for passing the College Placement Test or PERT are set and met each year as is the goal for students to pass 90% of their classes with a grade of C or better.

CONCLUSIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS

SPCHS met 4 of 4 goals for the 2019-2020 school year. The 10th-grade FSA ELA goal could not be evaluated. 100% (67 of 67 students) were college ready as measured by passage of the college placement test or PERT. 100% of seniors graduated with a high school diploma (85 of 85). 95% (81 of 85) graduated with an A.A. degree. 94% of classes (2044 of 2181) were passed with a grade of C or higher.

SPCHS outcomes were again near ceiling levels for the 2019-2020 school year. A five-year review indicates that SPCHS has met each goal set in this timeframe. Strong outcomes are expected given that the class is pre-selected from among highly motivated students. Any school with economically disadvantaged students in the 20% range is expected to receive a school grade of A and perform well each year. Yet, students at SPCHS exceed expectations through receipt of the A.A. degree and consistent strong performance each year. SPCHS should set and meet similar goals central to its' mission for the 2020-2021 school year.
