
SAINT PETERSBURG COLLEGIATE HIGH SCHOOL NORTH EVALUATION: 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

SPCHS North met 4 of 4 goals for the 2019-2020 school year. The 10th-grade FSA ELA goal could not be evaluated due to the cancellation of state assessment testing. 93% (58 of 62) of students were college ready as measured by passage of the college placement test or PERT. 100% of seniors graduated with a high school diploma (20 of 20). 100% (20 of 20) graduated with 20 or more college credits. 93% (1160 of 1239) of classes were passed with a grade of C or higher.

While SPCHS North graduates met each goal set, there was room for improvement in college placement test scores and the percentage of classes passed with a grade of C or higher. The return of assessments for the 2020-2021 school year allowed tracking of performance toward passage of the FSA ELA assessment. SPCHS North chose to set conservative goals for the 2020-2021 school. In each case, goals were set below baselines. Challenges associated with Covid and limited baseline information for SPCHS North contributed to this decision.

GOALS

- 1: By the end of the 2020-2021 school year, 90% of SPCHS sophomores will be college ready as measured by the College Placement Test or PERT (Baseline: 93%).
- 2: By the end of the 2020-2021 school year, 80% of the SPCHS students who are required to take the Florida Standards Assessment in English Language Arts will pass. (2018-2019 Baseline: 95%)
- 3: By the end of the 2020-2021 school year, 90% of SPCHS seniors currently enrolled will graduate with a high school diploma. (Baseline: 100%)
- 4: By the end of the 2020-2021 school year, 80% of SPCHS seniors currently enrolled will graduate with an Associate in Arts degree. (Baseline: 100%)
- 5: By the end of the 2020-2021 school year, SPCHS students will earn a grade of C or higher in 85% OF their college courses. (Baseline: 93%)

GOAL ANALYSIS

1. BY THE END OF THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR, 90% OF SPCHS SOPHOMORES WILL BE COLLEGE READY AS MEASURED BY THE COLLEGE PLACEMENT TEST OR PERT (BASELINE: 93%).

100% (75 of 75) of the SPCHS sophomore class for 2020-2021 were college ready as measured by the College Placement Test or PERT. This goal was met.

GOAL MET

2: BY THE END OF THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR, 80% OF THE SPCHS STUDENTS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE THE FLORIDA STANDARDS ASSESSMENT IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS WILL PASS. (2018-2019 BASELINE: 95%)

91% (67 of 74) of SPCHS sophomores and 97% (77 of 79) of juniors passed the FSA ELA. Combined, 94.1% (144 of 153) of students passed. This goal was met.

GOAL MET

3: BY THE END OF THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR, 90% OF SPCHS SENIORS CURRENTLY ENROLLED WILL GRADUATE WITH A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA. (BASELINE: 100%)

100% (63 of 63) of seniors graduated with a high school diploma. This goal was met.

GOAL MET

4: BY THE END OF THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR, 80% OF SPCHS SENIORS CURRENTLY ENROLLED WILL GRADUATE WITH AN ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE. (BASELINE: NA)

92% (58 of 63) of seniors graduated with an Associate in Arts degree. This goal was met.

GOAL MET

5: BY THE END OF THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR, SPCHS STUDENTS WILL EARN A GRADE OF C OR HIGHER IN 85% OF THEIR COLLEGE COURSES. (BASELINE: 93%)

SPCHS students earned a grade of C or higher in 89.4% (1631 of 1824) of their college courses. This goal was met.

CONCLUSIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS

SPCHS North met 5 of 5 goals for the 2020-2021 school year. 100% of sophomores were college ready as measured by the college placement test or PERT. 91% of sophomores and 97% of juniors passed the FSA ELA. 100% of seniors graduated with a high school diploma, with 92% of these graduating with an A.A. degree. Students earned a C or higher in 89.4% of college courses taken.

The percentage of students passing the FSA ELA assessment and earning a C in their college courses declined minimally from baselines yet met the established goals. PERT results improved from 93% to 100% passage. All seniors again graduated with a high school diploma. In the first year of eligibility, 92% of seniors earned an A.A. degree.

Goals should be set higher for the 2021-2022 school year based upon establishing baselines at the new location in each goal area. Goal 1 can remain at 90% or raised to 95% of sophomores passing the college placement test or PERT with prior baselines at 93% and 100%. Similarly, the FSA ELA goal can be raised from 80% to 90% with prior baselines of 95% and 94.1%. Goal 3 for graduating with a high school diploma can be raised to 95% with baselines of 100% for two years. Goal 4 for graduating with an A.A. degree can be raised to 90% with a baseline of 92%. Goal 5 can be raised to 90% of college courses passed with baselines of 93% and 89.4%. SPCHS North has demonstrated initial results to be strong similar to results for SPCHS South. Establishment of challenging goals is recommended.
