SAINT PETERSBURG COLLEGIATE HIGH SCHOOL NORTH EVALUATION: 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR

SPCHS-N had met 4 of 5 goals for the 2021-2022 school year. 100% of students were college ready based on PERT assessments (Goal: 95%). 100% of seniors graduated with a high school diploma (Goal: 95%) with 93.5% earning an A.A. degree (Goal: 87%). Students earned a "C" or higher in 92.7% of their college courses (Goal: 88%). SPCHS-N did not meet its goal for FSA ELA passage (Goal: 85%/Result: 79%).

In its third year of operation, challenging goals were set by SPCHS-N based upon established baselines and a review of the current cohort. Students met goals in four of the five core areas. Graduation metrics continued to be strong. PERT results met expectations and course passage was stronger than baseline despite concerns that continued challenges associated with Covid-19 would continue to affect this outcome. FSA ELA passage was the only area that did not meet expectations. The difference between the goal of 85% and the result of 79% was determined by 3 students not passing who were expected to pass.

For the 2022-2023 school year, challenging goals were set based on a review of the current cohort. An absenteeism goal was set in light of challenges associated with attendance across schools due to COVID-19. SPCHS-N chose to set Goal 2 at 79% for passage of the ELA FAST assessment. This goal was a reasonable conservative floor estimate for the first year of FAST administration although results could be higher given baselines.

GOALS

Goal 1: By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, 95% of SPCHS-N sophomores will be college ready as measured by the College Placement Test or PERT. (Baseline: 100%)

Goal 2: By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, 79% of the SPCHS-N students who are required to take the FAST assessment in ELA will pass. (FSA Baseline: 79%)

Goal 3: By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, 95% of SPCHS-N seniors currently enrolled will graduate with a high school diploma. (Baseline: 100%)

Goal 4: By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, 90% of SPCHS-N seniors currently enrolled will graduate with an Associate in Arts degree. (Baseline: 93.5%)

Goal 5: By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, SPCHS-N students will earn a grade of C or higher in 90% OF their college courses. (Baseline: 92.7%)

Goal 6: SPCHS-N will reduce its chronic absenteeism rate below the prior year baseline (Baseline: 14.3%)

GOAL ANALYSIS

Please note that baselines are results at SPCHS-N from the prior year cohort. Some goals are set below baselines for SPCHS-N as they are based on expectations of the current cohort.

GOAL 1: BY THE END OF THE 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR, 95% OF SPCHS-N SOPHOMORES WILL BE COLLEGE READY AS MEASURED BY THE COLLEGE PLACEMENT TEST OR PERT. (BASELINE: 100%)

100% of sophomores (48 of 48) were college ready as measured by the College Placement Test or PERT. This goal was met.

GOAL 2: BY THE END OF THE 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR, 79% OF THE SPCHS-N STUDENTS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE THE FAST ASSESSMENT IN ELA WILL PASS. (FSA BASELINE: 79%)

94% of students (45 of 48) earned a Level 3 or higher on the FAST PM3 assessment. This goal was met

GOAL MET

GOAL 3: BY THE END OF THE 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR, 95% OF SPCHS-N SENIORS CURRENTLY ENROLLED WILL GRADUATE WITH A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA. (BASELINE: 100%)

100% of seniors (69 of 69) graduated with a high school diploma. This goal was met.

GOAL MET

GOAL 4: BY THE END OF THE 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR, 90% OF SPCHS-N SENIORS CURRENTLY ENROLLED WILL GRADUATE WITH AN ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE. (BASELINE: 93.5%)

97% of seniors (67 of 69) graduated with an Associate in Arts degree. This goal was met.

GOAL MET

GOAL 5: BY THE END OF THE 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR, SPCHS-N STUDENTS WILL EARN A GRADE OF C OR HIGHER IN 90% OF THEIR COLLEGE COURSES. (BASELINE: 92.7%)

Students earned a "C" or higher in 94.6% (1625 of 1718) of their college courses. This goal was met.

GOAL 6: SPCHS-N WILL REDUCE ITS CHRONIC ABSENTEEISM RATE BELOW THE PRIOR YEAR BASELINE (BASELINE: 14.3%)

The chronic absenteeism rate at SPCHS-N declined to 8.3%. This goal was met.

CONCLUSIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS

SPCHS-N met 6 of 6 goals for the 2022-2023 school year. 100% of seniors graduated with a high school diploma, with 97% (67of 69) graduating with an Associate in Arts degree. Assessment passage was strong with 100% of sophomores assessed as college ready and 94% (45 of 48) scoring at Level 3 or higher on the FAST PM3 assessment. SPCHS-N students received a 'C' or higher in 94.6% of their college courses and the chronic absenteeism rate declined to 8.3% from 14.3% the year prior.

SPCHS-N students continue to demonstrate near ceiling levels of performance across outcomes. The challenge for goal setting at SPCHS-N is to set goals that are consistent with SPCHS-N's high expectations while allowing for yearly variability associated with small sample size. SPCHS-N is encouraged to set goals for the 2023-2024 school year across metrics that are challenging based upon expectations of the currently enrolled cohort.
