COMMUNITY

St. Petersburg Collegiate High School is a charter school operated by St. Petersburg College and under the umbrella of Pinellas County Schools. Pinellas County is the sixth largest county in the state with over 900,000 residents. The county is a peninsula that is bordered by the Gulf of Mexico on the west and Tampa Bay on the east. The white sand beaches are popular with tourists from around the world.

SPCHS students will simultaneously earn a high school diploma, an Associate in Arts degree, and a Bright Futures scholarship.

ACADEMIC CURRICULUM

St. Petersburg College (SPC) opened St. Petersburg Collegiate High School (SPCHS) in 2004 to offer students in grades 10–12 a unique choice that melds secondary and post-secondary curriculum leading to the obtainment of a high school diploma and an Associate in Arts degree. Admission to SPCHS is by application and students are selected via a random lottery. Grade 10 applicants are required to have a passing GPA. College ready PERT scores are not required for 10th grade. Grade 11 applicants must have an unweighted GPA of 3.0, passing college placement (PERT) scores, and passed Algebra I and Geometry.

St. Petersburg Collegiate High School consists of two programs: The Pre-Collegiate Program for students in Grade 10 and the Collegiate Program for students in grades 11–12. The tenth-grade curriculum supports three major objectives: mastery of the Florida Standards, completion of required courses for high school graduation, and preparation for college-level academics (no IB/AP/AICE offered). Students in the Collegiate Program are fully dual enrolled in all college coursework leading to the completion of the requirements for an Associate in Arts degree [College Catalog || St. Petersburg College \(spcollege.edu\)](http://College Catalog || St. Petersburg College (spcollege.edu)). All college courses are taught by SPC professors on the St. Petersburg/Gibbs campus. Students in the Collegiate Program also participate in the SPCHS Leadership Program and create an electronic portfolio as part of the Senior Capstone Night.

- Pass the Algebra I End of Course Exam Students
- Pass the Grade 10 English Language Arts F.A.S.T.
- 4 credits English 1 credit Fine Arts
- 1 credit Health and Physical Education
- 8 elective credits
- Minimum 2.0 GPA required

REQUIREMENTS FOR AN ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE

- 6 credits college-level Mathematics
- 6 credits Communications
- 3 credits World View
- 6 credits Humanities
- 6 credits Social and Behavioral Science
- 6 credits Natural Sciences including lab
- Foreign Language requirement (2 years high school, 2 semesters college credit, or pass the Foreign Language Equivalency Test)
- Computer Literacy Course
- 3 credits Ethics
